SUMMARY

The Director of TOGETHER for the Long Run ensures that the event runs smoothly and fulfills our vision of impacting, empowering and celebrating all of our abilities. The Director will work closely with the Founder, Fiscal Agent (United Way), High School Executive Director, Outreach Team Leader, Awareness Team Leader, and Event Planning Team Leader. Time required is approximately: 1-2 hours/week in the Fall, an estimated 5-10 hours/week January – March, and between 20-40 hrs/week in April-May. There is an hourly wage of \$17/hour.
